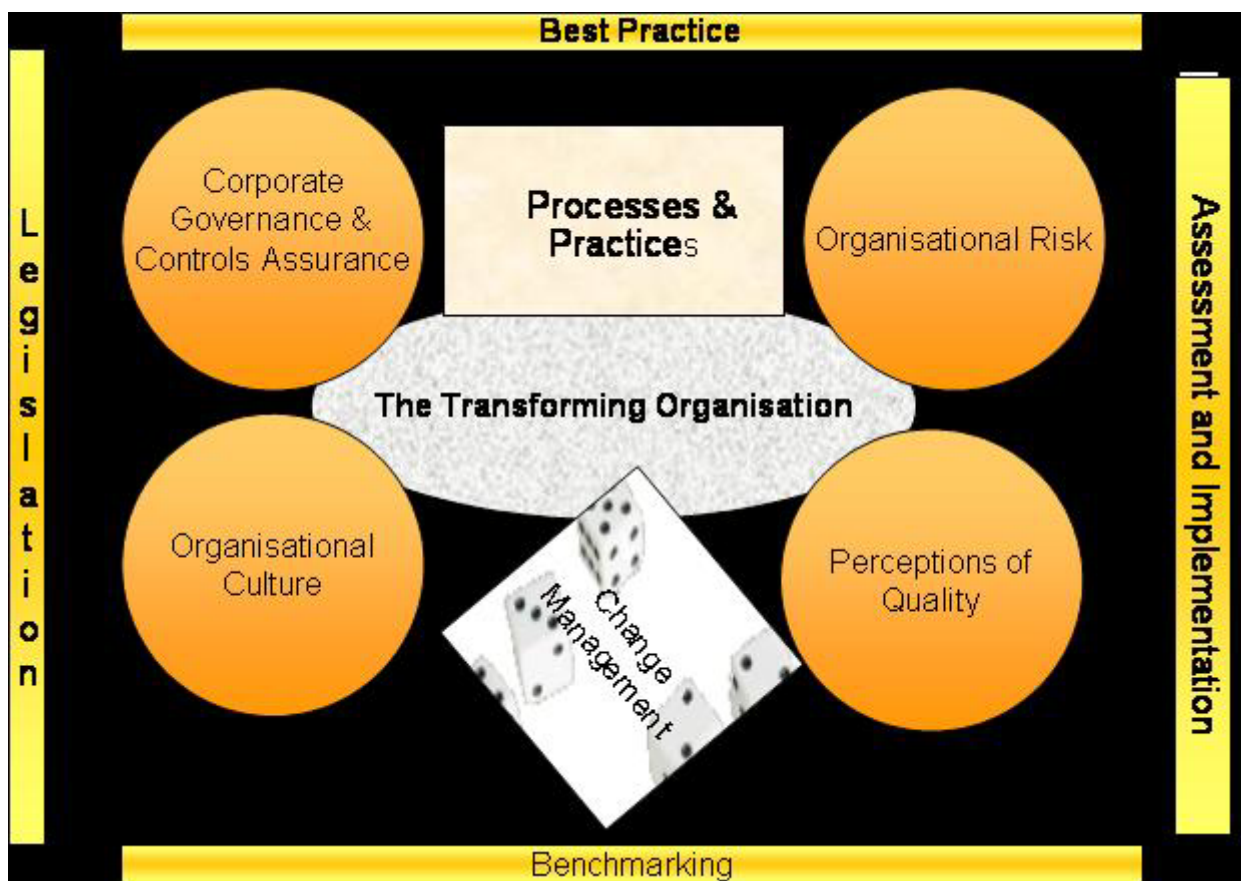


Unravelling the Risk Conundrum
